However, it was Chilman who took charge late in the series with four wins in a row to end the series and crown him champ while Vandiver and Jones got second and third place in the Mini class.

Another battle that was quickly brought to an end was in the Junior A class. **Michael Huddleston** pulled a good win for the day. Off the start, Huddleston shot into the lead but a mile or so into the course, he got stuck which allowed KTM mounted **Devin Walker** to squeeze by and lead the first lap. After getting unstuck, Huddleston found himself in third place behind **Jeremiah "Billygoat" Bowman**. When the trio came through on the second lap, Huddleston maneuvered the lead and that's how the three of them finish. Huddleston came away with a win followed by Walker and Bowman.

The win was not enough to overcome **Tanner Byarly's** points lead though. Huddleston finished second in the points to Byarly and third place overall went to Walker.

It was an awesome day to end the Winter Series and all are looking forward to the next season!
